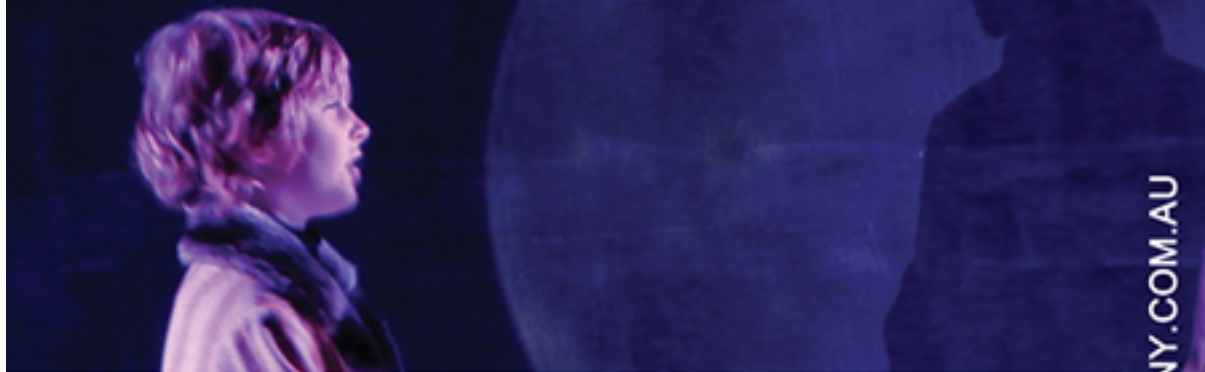

CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

TYC provides supervision of young people during course hours only.

CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT CONT.

In booking into a TYC Program course, participants (or their parents/ guardians) acknowledge that TYC activities are physical and may involve the risk of accidents occurring.

TYC may take and use photographs and videos of course participants for promotional and archival purposes.

Parents must advise TYC in advance of the course if their child has health problems and/or requires medication while attending a course. TYC tutors take care of children during their classes, but cannot be responsible for the administration of medication or ensuring suitable health precautions are in place to suit all participants.

Should staff deem necessary for an ambulance to be called the cost will be incurred by the participant or their guardian/parent.

ENROLMENT INFORMATION

TUTORS All TYC tutors are highly skilled theatre practitioners and teachers. All TYC tutors teaching young people have been screened with the Commission for Children and Young People and Child Guardian

PARENTS TYC does not allow observation of classes by parents unless an open session has been organised. This gives young people the freedom to develop without the pressure of observation by adults.

CONFIRMATION OF COURSES Once there are sufficient numbers for us to confirm a course, you will receive a confirmation letter by mail or email. If we are unable to offer you a place in your chosen course, we will contact you to check if you prefer to attend another course or would like a refund.
