We conduct our programs throughout the Cairns region including Trinity Beach, Edmonton, Redlynch, Freshwater and Cairns City in our Adventure Theatre with lights, sound, projections, costumes, sets, props. You name it – we have it.

What inspired you to start The Young Company?

When I headed down to Brisbane to study my Bachelor of Theatre and Education I was introduced to the concepts surrounding Youth Theatre. I then travelled throughout Europe and America for two years exploring the concepts further. When I moved back to Cairns I decided to make the big leap and create my own youth theatre company.

Tell us about the different programs on offer:

Over the last eight years we have been able to develop a range of youth theatre programs for three to 25 year olds which cover everything from Acting, Musical Theatre, Singing, Dancing, Backstage Management, Technical Theatre, Directing, Internships, Costume and Prop Making, Mentorships, Improvisation.

We also do Drama Education Programs, where we visit both primary and secondary schools during school time and connect in with the curriculum.

How do you spend your free time?

I like to head down to the beach and enjoy the beautiful Cairns weather. My boys also love to head to Sugarworld and Paradise Palms to chill out too.
